Japan is the Core State of Japanese Civilization and Russia is the Core State of Orthodox Civilization. After the above

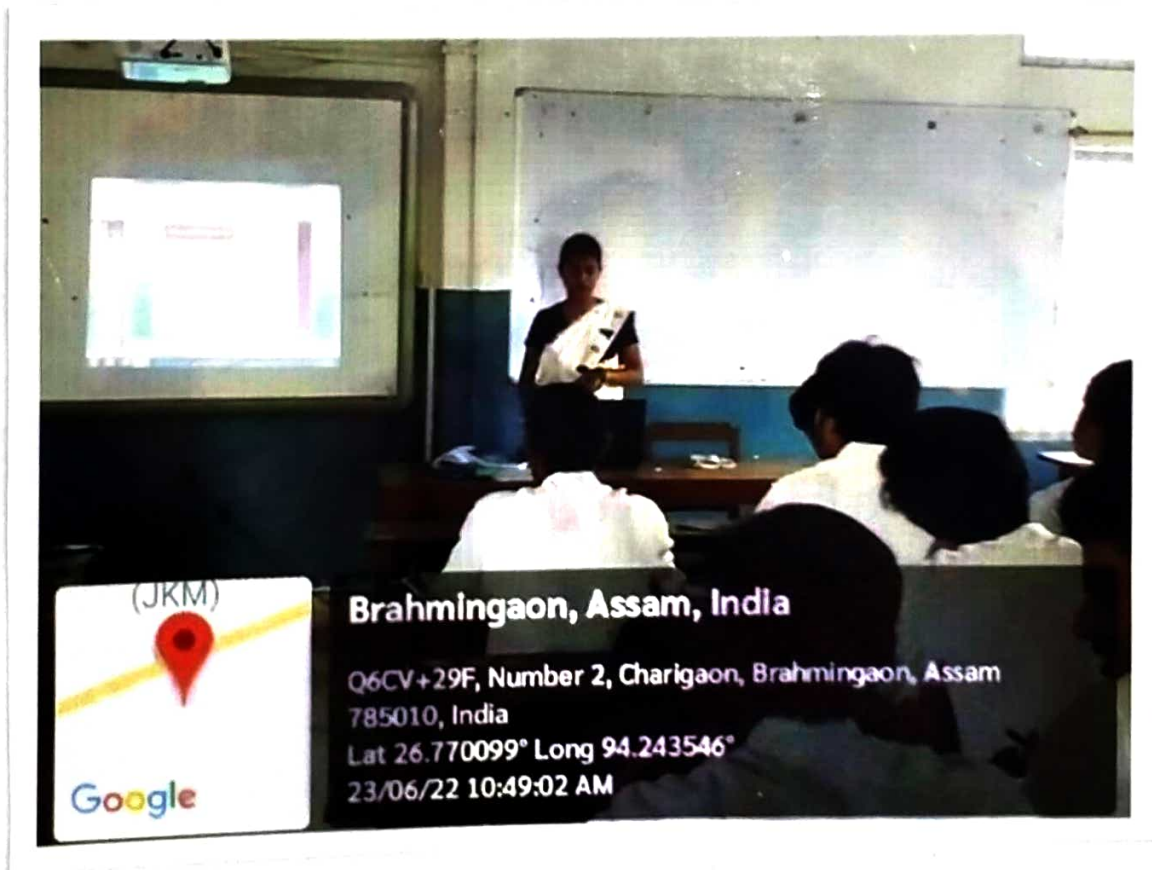
discussions, a lively interaction from students were made which has been cleared in each of the PPT classes.

A brief report on Power Point Presentation Class taken by Miss Bonnya Phukan on *Public Policy* and

***Clashes of Civilization*, dated 19-05-2022 and 23-06-2022 respectively.**

1. Power Point Presentation Class 1 (Date: 19-05-2022, Class: B.A. 4th Semester Honours, Time: 1 pm, Room No: 4) :

The topic of the first PPT class was Public Policy. The class begins with introduction and meaning of Public Policy.

The nature and types of Public Policy also has been discussed in the class. The models of Public Policy namely Systems

Model, Institutional Model, Rational Model, Lindblom's Incremental Model, Simon's Satisfying Policy Making Model,

Dror's Normative-Optimum Model, Mixed Model and Political Public Policy Model were discussed briefly.

The Central Secretariat, the Cabinet Secretariat, the Prime Minister and his Office, NITI Ayoga etc important institutions which influence the policy making process in India also have been discussed in this PPT class.

2. Power Point Presentation Class 2 (Date: 23-05-2022, Class: B.A. 2nd Semester Honours, Time: 10 am, Room No: 5) :

The topic of the second PPT class was Clashes of Civilization. The class begins with the history and meaning of Cold War.

The end of the Cold War in the early 1990s and the various perspectives in the post Cold War world also has been discussed in the PPT class.

The main argument of Samuel P. Huntington about the Clash of Civilization theory was the central point of this class.

According to Huntington, there are eight different types of civilization in the world. They are-

- (i) Western Civilization,
- (ii) Japanese Civilization,
- (iii) Orthodox Civilization,
- (iv) Latin-American Civilization,
- (v) Sinic or Confucian Civilization,
- (vi) Islamic Civilization,
- (vii) Hindu Civilization and
- (viii) African Civilization.
